

**Professor Francesco Annunziato**  
**Editor-in-Chief *Immunology Letters***



Professor Francesco Annunziato has been the Director of the Diagnostic Centre for Cytofluorimetry and Immunotherapy, University Hospital Careggi, Florence since 2016. His background is in biological sciences, graduating from the University of Florence in 1994 and completing his PhD in clinical immunology in 1999. His work has focused on human Th cell subsets characterization and their roles in disease, human T regulatory cells (Treg) characterization, and characterization of the immunomodulatory activity of human mesenchymal stem cells. He has published more than 160 publications. He has won numerous awards including the GB Rossi Award for the best publication in Italy in the field of HIV research and is a member of several scientific societies including the Henry Kunkel Society. He has been on the review and editorial boards for several journals including *Frontiers in Pro-inflammatory Cytokines*, *PloS ONE*, *International Archives of Allergy*, and *Immunology Clinical and Molecular Allergy*. Furthermore, he has been the Editor-in-Chief of both Official Journals of EFIS, firstly, in 2016 by becoming the Chairperson of the Executive Committee of the *European Journal of Immunology*, and in 2019 by becoming Editor-in-Chief of *Immunology Letters*.
