We seek a highly-motivated and self-sufficient post doc to join our growing human immunology laboratory. Candidates should possess or soon possess PhD degrees in immunology, cell/molecular biology, genetics or related fields. The available position is to study epigenetic regulation of healthy and diseased germinal center reactions using genome wide technologies including RNA-seq, ChIP-seq and ATAC-seq. The post doc filling this position will also have opportunities to work on/lead high-impact disease discovery projects. Competitive candidates need to possess experience in flow cytometry, cell sorting and molecular biology. Experience and/or interest in genome editing and analysis of large genomic data sets would be helpful.

The offered position is funded for approximately five years. Post-docs will have opportunities to present scientific data at local, national and international meetings. Salary is competitive and will depend upon qualifications and previous training. An autumn 2019 start date is preferred. Institutional assistance for obtaining a VISA to work in the United States (U.S.) is available.

Research activity will take place in a highly academic environment. The lab is located on the 12th floor of the Abramson Research Center, a part of Children's Hospital Philadelphia (CHOP) Research Institute. The institute is one of the largest and prestigious pediatric research programs in the U.S. with 425 full time investigators working in 700,000 square feet across three dedicated research buildings. CHOP is situated within the University of Pennsylvania Campus and is home to the Pediatrics Faculty of the University of Pennsylvania Perelman School of Medicine, an Ivy League medical school. This rich, intellectual environment is ideal for the conduct of interdisciplinary and innovative research.

Philadelphia, the 6th most-populous U.S. city, provides a dynamic cultural environment and numerous forms of entertainment. Philadelphia is easy to access through its large international airport. New York City and Washington D.C. are only 90 minutes by train.
